The family gathers round a table or sits in their living room and lights a candle.*

Readings        *The Sunday readings are read by different members of the family*

Reflection      *If anyone would like to say what struck them from the readings do so now*

We believe God is everyone's Father

We believe God loves us and cares for us

We believe in the Lord Jesus Christ

We believe Jesus is God's Son and messenger

We believe Jesus died on the cross for us to give us life

We believe Jesus rose from the dead

We believe Jesus is still beside us

We believe in the Holy Spirit, which is God's life in us  
We believe the church is a big family that has been brought together  
We believe the Church is God's home  
We believe we will live for ever with Jesus
